Our knowledge and experience removes much of this complexity and allows our customers to focus on product marketing, safe in the knowledge that key areas of board assembly and box build are in good hands."

## **Understanding approvals**

Elite understands the duty, tax and legal implications when trading in the USA and with PCB assembly in the UK and final box build in the USA, customers can use the vital 'assembled in the USA'

badge. US approval and quality accreditation is also key and Elite holds UL approved and US ISO9001: 2008 accreditation.

After testing, the products are released market ready for the customer. We provide a one stop shop for trade in the USA."
